

Machu Picchu New Entry Regulation



Visit shifts

There are 9 shifts to visit the citadel which is open from 6:00am to 5:30pm

People per shift : 99/100

People per day: 897



Basic measures

Obligatory use of face mask.



Social distancing must be kept at all times.

Temperature check at the entrance to the citadel.



Allowed groups

The groups allowed will be of **07 PEOPLE** maximum per guide.



Alternative Hikes

The following alternative hikes will be close until further notice:

- Huayna Picchu Mountain
- Machu Picchu Mountain
- Inti Punku
- Inca Bridge



Inka Trail

The 4D/3N Inka Trail will be closed for the moment being.



The 2D/1N Inka Trail will allow 100 people daily, in groups of 7 people maximum per guide.



Buses

Buses will work with a limited capacity to guarantee social distancing, and a timing difference of 10 minutes per bus.



Trains

Trains will operate at 100% capacity with Hepa filter sanitization. Passengers must:

1. Wear facial shield and mask.
2. Present health affidavit.
