NEWS, TRIPS & TRENDS

AdventureSmith's adventure specialists are following news and trends in adventure travel this winter and beyond. Here's some of what we're watching:

- Early-season <u>Antarctica expeditions</u> to see the **emperor penguin colony on Snow Hill Island** saw great success last month (November 2024). Opportunities to visit this remote island increase next season with another helicopter-equipped ship routing there, along with other new dedicated Weddell Sea itineraries.
- We're seeing **uncommon 2025** <u>Alaska charter yacht</u> **availability** still but expect this space to rapidly diminish in January. Ask us about all the nuances of chartering your own yacht for 8 to 12 guests.
- Many more compact <u>Arctic cruise</u> routes are about to launch starting in late April 2025. Ask our experts about which popular itineraries will now have shorter variations, or <u>sort and filter all our</u> <u>Arctic expeditions by trip length</u>.



- Also in the Arctic, new regulations to help with wildlife conservation start on January 1, 2025. Among the new guidelines are increased polar bear distance requirements for ships, along with the restriction of ships carrying more than 200 guests to visit national parks and preserves. AdventureSmith's <u>Svalbard cruise</u> options are primarily aboard ships under 200 guests so remain largely unaffected in route.
- Solo travel is on the rise, and ship operators are paying attention. In addition to new ships being built with dedicated single-occupancy cabins, we're seeing increasing incentives and waived single supplement blocks coming in 2025.
